What is our role?

- We have been working with the Forum for some time
- We have helped the Forum gain funding from the City Council – this gives us a budget to carry out traffic modelling
- What we model is up to the community we will facilitate a community design workshop in late spring to early summer 2018
- Before that, University students will be carrying traffic surveys under our direction



What are the principles?

- Moseley SPD has set out the principles of streets needing to have greater pedestrian priority
- Conflict between Alcester
 Road being a major route into
 Birmingham but also a local
 High Street
- And a holistic approach ...

Mixed priority streets
Complete streets
































What next?

- Uni of Birmingham students are collecting traffic data in the next few months
 - -Volunteers still needed!
- We will facilitate a design workshop with a community design group – Spring 2018



- Students will analyse traffic data and the results will be presented to this design group
- After the community design, we will take away the concepts and test it using traffic simulation software
- We will report the outcomes to the Forum in Autumn 2018 for a public consultation and then final agreement on a design for Moseley
